The Snowman had been with another Councillor who was acting as chaperone at the time. It was noted that the steps were damp due to the weather conditions however the steps were designed for outdoor use. It was noted that the incident had not been reported to St John Ambulance. The individual had decided to deal with the pain themselves.

Members discussed the recent nosebleed experienced by a member of staff whilst cleaning the Town Hall toilets. It was noted that full PPE had been worn and there was free air flow. It was felt that this was not caused by the work being undertaken.
