OUR LOCAL BEAT OFFICERS INFORMED US THAT THEY HAVE VISITED OVER 62 PLACES OF EDUCATION SPEAKING TO YOUNG PEOPLE INCLUDING 9 VISITS TO SECONDARY/HIGH SCHOOLS, 4 CHILDREN'S HOMES AND 25 VISITS TO PRIMARY SCHOOLS THIS WAS A PRIORITY FROM OUR LAST MEETING TO ENGAGE WITH CHILDREN.

WE WERE TOLD CHILDREN WERE AFRAID TO REPORT ASSAULTS THEY HAD ENCOUNTERED AGAINST THEMSELVES.

WE WERE ASKED BY A COUNCILLOR ABOUT KNIFE CRIME AND WE DISCUSSED THIS WITH THE POLICE OFFICERS PRESENT THERE IS NOT A PROBLEM WITH KNIFE CRIME IN DOWNHAM MARKET. KNIFE CRIME DOES INCLUDE CARRYING SHARP INSTRUMENTS EG SCISSORS. IT DID DECREASE BY ALMOST 15% IN MARCH 2024.

FROM MONDAY 13TH TO SUNDAY 19TH MAY 2024 THERE WAS A NATIONAL SCHEME CALLED OPERATION SCEPTRE TO VISIT RETAILERS OFFERING EDUCATION AND ADVICE ON SALE OF KNIVES.
