1. E-Scooter/E-Bike usage alongside other anti social use of vehicles.
2. Youth Engagement/Education around ASB and Criminal Damage.

Your Beat Managers have continued to conduct targeted patrols across the Downham Market area. We have been issuing formal ASB warnings to repeat youth offenders (including informing their parents) and actively dispersing them from the town for up to 48hrs where appropriate. This also allows officers to seize bikes, speakers or anything else that is causing or is likely to cause ASB.

They have been working closely with the town council and local businesses including Tesco, Morrisons and the library to implement crime prevention measures in a bid to further reduce ASB in the town.

There has been a big push on the start up of Neighbourhood Watch schemes in the local area and PC FISHER and PC LORRAINE ran an engagement surgery at Morrisons to speak with the public and promote the scheme.
