	The Mayor advised that:
	The local elections take place on 4 May. Photo ID is required to vote at a polling station. Pre-election time starts today. Nominations for Parish Council elections must be handed in by 4 April 2023
	That the St Winnolds Event on Friday 17 March 2023 had been successful and he had enjoyed looking at the children's artwork.
	Hollies Number 2 car park is closed for patching from Tuesday evening this week. The patching on the Paradise Road and Priory Road Car park were completed last week.
	The date for the Annual Town Council Meeting has been set for 16 May 2023, which is when the Council will select their Mayor for 2023/2024.
	On 3 April the scaffolding for the Town Hall re-roofing project will be put up and work will start from 11 April.
	CIL update – Council were successful in their application for funding to assist in the Town Hall kitchen refurbishment and have been awarded £20,000 by the Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk. Planning will begin after the elections in May 2023.
	The bid to the Parish Partnership was successful and we have been awarded £5,056.50 towards a SAM 2 speed device. The Town Council have to provide the remaining 50% of the cost which is unbudgeted. This will be discussed by the Council after the May elections. The funding has to be spent during 2023/24 financial year.
	The Community Hub finishes on 29 March 2023. There will be a Community Cinema following the Hub at 2:30pm where Mrs Harris goes to Paris will be shown and again at 7pm.
	Council have arranged 2 free Easter themed Cinemas. On 5 April there will be a showing of Matilda the Musical and on 12 April there will be a showing of Hop.
	Council are working hard to finalise the Coronation Event on 7 May 2023 and hope to announce the programme shortly.
	Hillcrest School has asked us to give an update on their Earthquake Appeal. They have raised over £2,000 and thank everyone for all the support which enabled them to do this. Also, the Town Council for providing the market stall free of charge.
	The Council have received a personal donation of £100 towards the Community Defibrillator scheme. A very big thank you for this. It is appreciated as it helps to site this vital equipment in another part of town.
